## CHICKEN WITH ROSEMARY BUTTER SAUCE FOR 2

### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 2 boneless, skinless Chicken Breast halves (4 oz each)
- 2 Tablespoons Butter, divided
- 1/4 cup White Wine or Chicken Broth
- 1/4 cup Heavy Whipping Cream
- 1 1/2 teaspoons Minced Fresh Rosemary



#### DIRECTIONS:

- 1. In a small skillet over medium heat, cook chicken in 1 tablespoon butter for 4-5 minutes on each side or until a thermometer reads 170°. Remove and keep warm.
- 2. Add wine to the pan; cook over medium-low heat, stirring to loosen browned bits from pan. Add cream and bring to a boil. Reduce heat; cook and stir until slightly thickened. Stir in rosemary and remaining butter until blended. Serve with chicken.

- A friendly reminder: rent is due on the first of the month. A late fee will be applied to rent not paid in full by 10:00 am on February 10th. The only forms of payment we accept are checks, money orders, or credit/debit cards (with a \$5 fee). Please do not drop cash or change in the drop box for payments. Please remember to add the \$5 fee to your online payment. This has been a problem and could be why some tenants still have a balance after paying rent.
- Residents, please note the extermination date for your building. Pest control will be done on Wednesday.
- If you have a maintenance emergency after hours or when the office is closed, please call 1-800-224-4787. Do not call the office phone after hours or on the weekends.
- Guest/Visitors must have a quest/visitor pass if staying overnight. They MUST park in the visitor area.

- All tenants must have a Brook Villas parking pass placed on the windshield. If you are a tenant and do not have one, please bring your current registration to the Property Manager, and one will be assigned.
- Please pick up your trash. We want to keep the property looking nice. Anyone found leaving trash in the breezeways will be fined.
- If the dumpsters are full, please do not leave trash outside the dumpsters or outside of your door.
- Please do not drag trash bags through the breezeways. It leaves the area looking unpleasant.
