CHICKEN WITH ROSEMARY BUTTER SAUCE FOR 2

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 boneless, skinless Chicken Breast halves (4 oz each)
- 2 Tablespoons Butter, divided
- 1/4 cup White Wine or Chicken Broth
- 1/4 cup Heavy Whipping Cream
- 1 1/2 teaspoons Minced Fresh Rosemary

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. In a small skillet over medium heat, cook chicken in 1 tablespoon butter for 4-5 minutes on each side or until a thermometer reads 170°. Remove and keep warm.
- 2. Add wine to the pan; cook over medium-low heat, stirring to loosen browned bits from pan. Add cream and bring to a boil. Reduce heat; cook and stir until slightly thickened. Stir in rosemary and remaining butter until blended. Serve with chicken.

- Happy Valentine's Day!

- A friendly reminder that rent is due on the first day of the month. Please do not drop blank or incomplete money orders/checks in the drop box. Money orders/checks should be payable to "Hillcrest Manor," and your name and apartment number should be included in the memo. You may also use the QR code or go to https://bit.ly/HillcrestRent to pay your rent by card. <u>Please remember to add the \$5 technology fee when paying online or by QR code. Also be sure to include late fees to payments when they apply.</u>

COMMUNITY CORNER CONTINUED

- Any payments made to management are applied to past due balances (Rent, Court, Late Fees, Damages, etc.) before being applied to current balances. The only time payments will not be applied to past due damages is if you have a <u>written</u> payment arrangement with management and it is current.
- Reminder: Do not flush wipes, even if labeled "flushable." They can clog pipes and cause sewage backups. Always throw them in the trash. Only toilet paper and human waste should be flushed.
- SMOKING MARIJUANA IS PROHIBITED ON THE PROPERTY. Although it is now legal in Virginia, it is not legal under Federal Law. We are a federally assisted property. Each tenant signed a drug-free addendum when moving into the property.
- Vehicles that are disabled or not properly licensed and inspected cannot be parked on the property. Please be courteous and have visitors park in the visitors' section. All curbs or paved spaces designated as fire lanes shall be indicated by yellow paint as approved by the Office of the Fire Code Official. Parking is not allowed in these areas.
- If you have been approved for an animal, it is your responsibility to clean up after them in all shared spaces, not just in your unit. Leaving pet waste can spread diseases and parasites, posing a health risk to others, especially children. When walking your pet in common areas, be attentive to where they are going to the bathroom and clean up immediately. Please use the free bags available at our pet waste station. Not adhering to this policy can result in the removal of your animal.
- Please be sure that you turn in maintenance items into the office. If you have a maintenance emergency after hours or when the office is closed, please use the emergency number 1-800-224-4748.
